Summer Term After School Clubs

Dear Parents,

It has been so good to see all the pupils settled back into school. We are delighted to be able to offer a number of after school clubs during the summer term (COVID restrictions permitting). Numbers will be limited per club and will be offered to either Years 3 & 4 or Years 5 & 6 to maintain our school bubbles. Membership to the club is on a first come, first served basis and we ask that you apply for no more than one club each half term. If we find we have space in other clubs, this will be communicated through e-mail and ClassDojo.

These clubs will be offered free of charge for the Summer Term as they are being fully funded from our government catch-up funding. While we're working really hard in school, we think that the most important "catch-up" children can do as we slowly come out of lockdown is to catch-up with friends, catch-up with some fun and catch-up with some outdoor and group activities. This is part of our drive to support our children to build positive friendships and encourage both healthy bodies and healthy minds.

In the first half term, the clubs will run for a 5 week period starting from the week beginning Monday 26th April. When we return after summer half term, the 5 week sessions will start on the week beginning Monday 7th June. The clubs will run from 3.30pm finish at 4.30pm. Please collect from the school playground as normal. It is envisaged that we will offer these (or similar) clubs in the next school year for a small weekly fee.

If your child joins a sports club, a PE kit will need be brought in on the day of the club. In this instance, we will not allow pupils to wear PE kits all day. The PE Kit will need to be clearly named and placed outside your child's classroom. They will have the opportunity to get changed prior to the start of the club.
