While we totally understand the temptation to whizz around on scooters and bikes, again please can I ask that all children "walk your wheels" when on our playground.



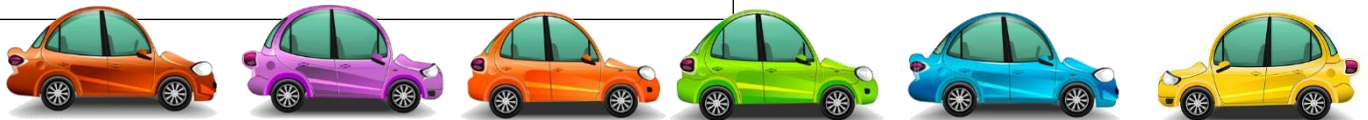
Beat the Street
