Year 5 Swimming

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that all Year 5 pupils will be taking part in swimming lessons at Moorways in the new academic year.

Children will swim each Wednesday afternoon throughout the year from the 14th September as part of their Statutory PE lessons. Unless we inform you otherwise, swimming **will** take place in the last week and the first week after half terms/end of term holidays.

Your child will need the following kit:

- A swimsuit or shorts (no bikinis please)
- A towel
- Goggles if preferred
- Hats are encouraged for all children

In the **Autumn term** Chatsworth (Y5 pupils only) and Buxton will go swimming.

In the **Spring term** Bakewell will go swimming.

Some pupils may be invited to join for further sessions to support them in developing their swimming ability in the Spring term.

Shelton Junior School is paying for every child's swimming lesson; however, a contribution to the transport costs for your child would be greatly appreciated. This is just a small donation of £1.50 a week.

This works out as the following per child for the entire term of swimming:

Autumn term 13 wks (Chatworth/Buxton)	£19.50
Spring term 12 wks (Bakewell)	£18.00

Together, we learn, trust and succeed.


Learn ... reach your full potential - *curiosity, concentration*
