Lovely to see everyone back at school today, just a few reminders as we get the next term underway.

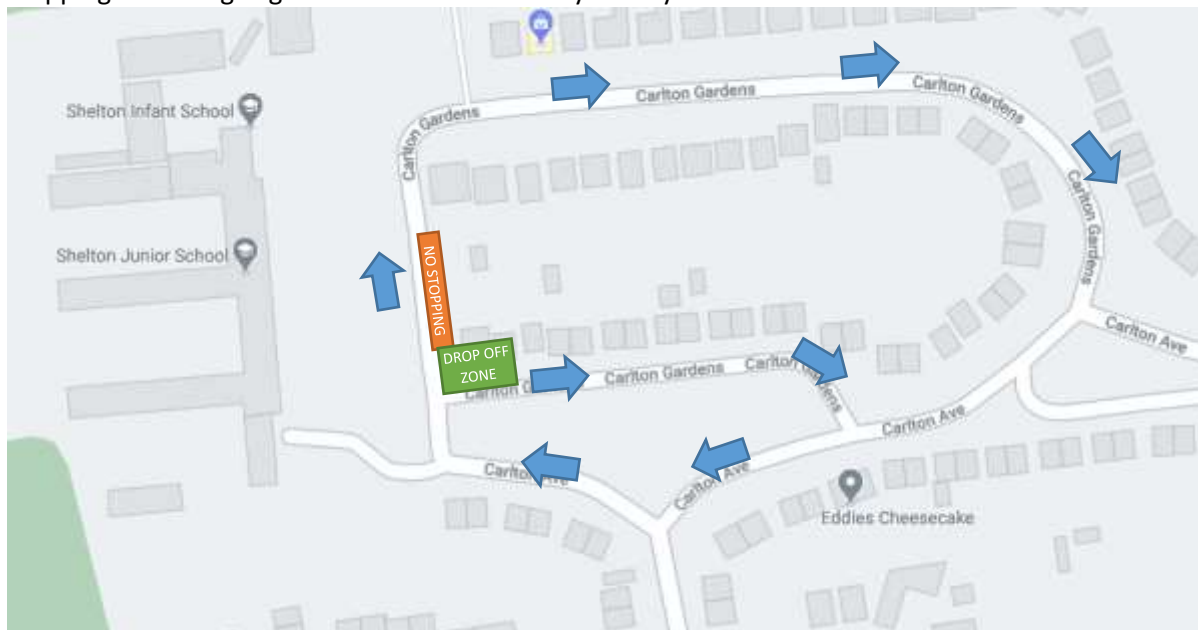
### Parking
